**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 150-9 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE
ENTITLED “FEES FOR LICENSES AND PERMITS” TO PERMIT
COLLECTION OF UNPAID MERCANTILE LICENSES & ADD LIMOUSINE
FEES**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that Ordinance 2026-02, with the foregoing title, was finally adopted following a public hearing at the February 17, 2026 Township Council Regular Meeting at 7 PM in the Council Chambers, One Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, Willingboro, New Jersey 08046. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish clear authority for the Municipal Clerk’s Office to assess and collect past-due mercantile license fees for prior years of operation in which a business failed to obtain the required license and add limousine fees to the municipal fee schedule to promote fairness, consistency, and effective regulation of commercial transportation services.
