AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 199 “HOUSING STANDARDS” ADDING AN ARTICLE ENTITLED” UNIFORM FIRE SAFETY INSPECTIONS” DESIGNATING THE TOWNSHIP OF WILLINGBORO AS THE LOCAL ENFORCING AGENCY FOR UNIFORM FIRE SAFETY INSPECTIONS RELATED TO THE CERTIFICATION OF SMOKE ALARMS, CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS, FIRE EXTINGUISHERS AND SECONDARY POWER SOURCES PURSUANT TO P.L. 2025, c.19

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that Ordinance 2026-05, with the foregoing title, was finally adopted following a public hearing at the March 3, 2026 Township Council Regular Meeting at 7 PM in the Council Chambers, One Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, Willingboro, New Jersey 08046. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish and implement uniform statewide requirements for fire safety inspections related to the certification of smoke alarms, carbon monoxide alarms, fire extinguishers, and secondary power sources, in accordance with P.L. 2025, c. 19. This ordinance ensures that such inspections are conducted in a consistent, standardized, and lawful manner for applicable property transactions and inspections within the municipality.
