ORDINANCE 2026-16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WILLINGBORO, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 252 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WILLINGBORO, ENTITLED “PEACE AND GOOD ORDER,” TO ADD A NEW ARTICLE IV, ENTITLED “SPECIAL EVENTS,” ESTABLISHING A FORMAL PROCESS FOR THE PERMITTING, REVIEW, COORDINATION, AND REGULATION OF SPECIAL EVENTS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Ordinance 2026-16, with the foregoing title, was finally adopted following the public hearing on the May 19, 2026, Township Council Regular Meeting in the Council Chambers, One Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, Willingboro, New Jersey 08046. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a clear, consistent, and transparent framework for the permitting, review, coordination, and regulation of special events, including certain events conducted on private property that are open to the public or of sufficient scale to impact traffic, public safety, or municipal resources, while ensuring that such regulation is administered in a content-neutral manner consistent with constitutionally protected First Amendment activities.
